



Proclamation of the Mayor

WHEREAS, Governor Greg Abbott issued a Proclamation on July 2, 2020 amending Executive Order GA-28 and mandating that certain outdoor gatherings in excess of 10 people is prohibited unless the mayor of the city in which the gathering is held, or the county judge in the case of a gathering in an unincorporated area, approves of the gathering;


WHEREAS, following the Governor's Proclamation, Collin County Judge Chris Hill issued a Proclamation on July 2, 2020, to permit citizens to have gatherings in excess of 10 people in the unincorporated areas of Collin County.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Angel Hamm, Mayor of the Town of New Hope, Texas, do hereby declare that pursuant to the Governor's Proclamation issued on July 2, 2020, citizens are permitted to have outdoor gatherings in excess of 10 people in the Town of New Hope.

This proclamation shall remain in effect and in full force for as long as Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-28 is in effect and in full force, unless otherwise modified, amended, rescinded, or superseded by the Mayor.
